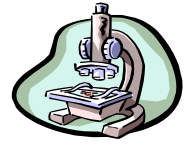

Health News Alert

In the past several months there have been several families in our community that have been victims of staff infections. Staff is being seen more and more in communities, not just in hospitals. Protect yourself and your family by covering any scratches or healing wounds with a bandage. If an area becomes staff it will look like a boil and the person infected should be seen by a physician. If at all possible, have the area cultured by your doctor to determine the appropriate medicine and protocol necessary to keep it from recurring. If left untreated, staff can become very serious.

OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE**Community Walk-thru - A follow up**

As a follow-up to the Spring Lakes Community Walk-Thru held in late August, the list of open items has been reviewed with the Spring Lakes Community Manager. A high percentage of the items were related to the common grounds, which included actions related to landscaping, re-seeding, natural debris cleanup and trash/unwanted materials clean-up. These items are expected to be addressed by end of November.

Various other action items such as leaning street lights and utility box issues have been reported to the respected utility companies. Other actions such as straightening street signs, painting storm water structures and fence repair will be addressed by various repair services.
