Safety Issues a Concern in Spring Lakes

Safety and security continue to be issues of concern in our neighborhood. In the past month we experienced vandalism in the single family community. There continues to be a problem with automobile break ins in the townhome area. Speeders are a big problem throughout our neighborhood.

We're asking everyone to attend our first meeting on the establishment of a neighborhood watch program. Terry Davis, from the Crime Prevention Office, will be our speaker.

School Bus Stop Law for Motorists

- When approaching a school bus with flashing signals or flashing signals and an extended stop sign on a public or private road, you **must stop and remain stopped** until all children are clear of the roadway and the bus moves again.
- You must also stop if a bus is loading or unloading children and the signal devices are not functioning properly.
- You do not have to stop, however, if you are traveling in the opposite direction on roadways separated by a physical barrier or unpaved median area.
- In Virginia, if you are convicted of passing a school bus that is stopped to load or unload passengers, you will receive a six-point violation that will stay on your record for 11 years.

Watch out for children getting on and off school buses and playing in the neighborhood. Please drive more cautiously. If you have teenage children who are driving, please make sure they understand how important it is to drive slowly in a neighborhood like Spring Lakes. We all have a responsibility for the safety of all children – please drive as though it is your child playing in and around the streets of Spring Lakes.

The members of the Safety Committee have noticed several items in the community that all homeowners should be more cautious about:

- ✓ Be sure your front lamp post light is on (replace all bulbs and, if necessary, push reset button to turn light on)
- ✓ Close your garage door when you enter your house
- ✓ Lock the door from your garage to your house
- ✓ Lock your front and back doors
- ✓ Lock your automobiles
- ✓ Keep your front entrance light on in the evening

If you see a street light out, please call Dominion Virginia Power at 1-888-667-3000. Each pole light has a label with a number on it. When you call have this number available and leave a message for street light repair.
