## Sheriff's Office Works to Decrease Number of False Alarms

- New Loudoun County ordinance requires homeowners and businesses with alarms to register with the Sheriff's Office and also includes a fining system for frequent offenders.
- Starting April 1<sup>st</sup> there is a three month grace period for false alarms. If a business or residence exceeds two false alarm responses during this period, they will receive a written letter of warning.
- After the grace period, which ends July 1<sup>st</sup>, any business or residence exceeding the allotted number of false alarms will be fined.
- Residences and businesses will be allowed two free false alarm responses per calendar year. On a third false alarm response, they will be fined \$100 and the amount of the fine will escalate for each additional false response.

\* \* \* \* \* Reminder to all homeowners about realtor signs \* \* \* \* \*

Realtor signs are not allowed at entrances to the community or other areas except on the property for sale or rent. The only exception to this rule is during the period that the property is being held as an "Open House". As soon as the open house is over, all realtor signs MUST be removed from the entrances and open space areas. Any signs that are not removed will be subject to removal by the HOA or its representatives. Please remind your realtor of this rule.
